Bubolz Family website: "Eldest son and brother. Came to the United States in Sept. 1856 with his Father, Mother, his three brothers, and his family. Had blue eyes, brown hair, light complexion, and was 5 ft. 4 1/2 In. Drafted into the U.S. Union Army on 29 Dec. 1864, into Company D Thirteenth Wisconsin Veterans Infantry. Died during the Civil War on 3 Sept. 1865 from disease in Victoria, Texas from Disease. Was married to Mina Bubolz and had three children: Mina (Born: 1851 Approx.), Emilie (Born: 1853 Approx.), and Augusta (Born: Jan 1856 Approx.)"
