Enlisted: September 10, 1861 as a Private from Manitowoc, WI. 22 year-old Fisherman, 5'9", brown eyes, brown hair.

Intra Regimental Company Transfer: January 1, 1864 from company C to company A.

Mustered Out: December 3, 1864

Married: Mary Henig, 1850-1878 on August 11, 1866
