Der Nord Westen, 13 July 1893: "Death yesterday in
Town Manitowoc of Fred Drumm of gastric trouble. He
was 63 yrs. 3 mos. 1 day of age and will be buried
Fri. afternoon."

Der Nord Westen, 24 August 1905: "Mrs. Fred Drumm,
(Jacobina) an old resident of our city in which
she has resided since 1854, died Fri. in the
residence of her son, C. A. Drumm, at the age
78. The deceased, whose husband died 12 yrs.
ago, leaves 6 children. The funeral was held
Sun. afternoon from the Lutheran Church."
