Der Nord Westen, 18 Feb. 1904: "Death Thurs. morning last week of M.H. Egan, a well-known farmer of Town Center-ville. The 60-yr. old man had been ill for a week, but no one anticipated that his end was near. Mr. Egan served in the Civil War with the 12th Wisconsin Regiment, and since 1900 had been a member of the Soldiers Assistance Committee of our county. He was a member of the local Post of the G.A.R."
