Enlisted: April 20, 1861 as a Private from Manitowoc, WI., 21 years old, 5'10", light hair

Promotion: February 10, 1862 to 2nd Lieutenant

Discharged for promotion: February 23, 1862

Commissioned in: 2nd WI Infantry, Company K

Wounded: August 28, 1862 at Gainesville, VA

Promotion: October 3, 1862 to 1st Lieutenant

Discharged: February 7, 1863 for disability.
