Oct.): "CONRAD FRANZ, one of our old veterans, was buried today under the auspices of the Local Post of the G.A.R. The 78-yr. old FRANZ fought in the Crimean War and after he came to America, also fought in our Civil War, from which service he drew a pension. He settled on a small farm near Range Line about 5 miles from here, and it was there that he died. His body was carried from there by the veteran's organization to the Catholic Church where his funeral was held. CONRAD FRANZ, a long-time subscriber to Der Nord Westen, leaves a sorrowing widow and several grown children."
