Mustered Out: June 26, 1865 on 6/26/1865

Pension Bureau: Sophia Greenwood, Mishicot, mother, awarded a pension of \$8 a month from June 1882.


Died: 28 February 1895

Buried: Evergreen Cemetery, Manitowoc, WI

George Greenwood/bur. 02-28-1895/age 71 yrs./cause: apoplexy/in G.A.R. lots.

Der Nord Westen, 07 Mar. 1895: "Last Thurs. morning, Rapids Road resident H.G. Greenwood sought to call his 72-year-old father (not named) down for breakfast. Getting no response, he went up and found the old gentlemen dead in his bed. A stroke is believed to have taken his life."
