"John Henricks, who your correspondent has known for years, is a cigar maker who learned his profession in Aschenburg, Bavaria. He is an old settler here who served in the Civil War but never received a pension. He has worked for several cigar factories in Manitowoc and has now told me that he is going to begin working for himself at 916 Madison St. in Manitowoc."
