Der Nord Westen, 26 January 1905: "A stroke took the life Thurs. last week of Edward Juul, a well-known resident of our city. The deceased, who was born in 1845 in Norway, came to America as a young man and settled in Manitowoc. In the last part of the war he served in Company G in the 7th Wisconsin Infantry Regiment. For many years he served as a clerk in the Schutte Bros. store until a few years ago when he opened a sweet shop, which he had to give up recently. He leaves a widow and 8 children. His funeral was held Sun. afternoon under the direction of the local Post of the G.A.R. and the Sons of Hermann Lodge, to both of which he belonged."
