

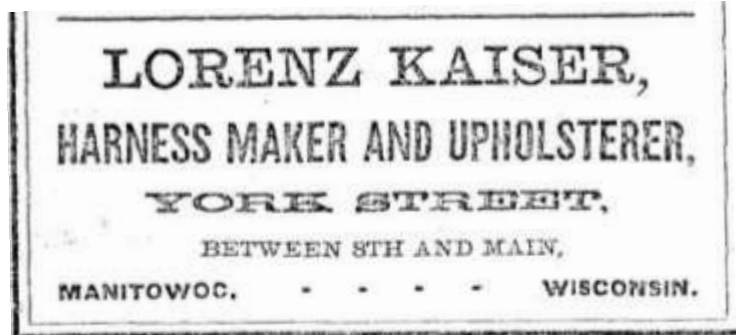

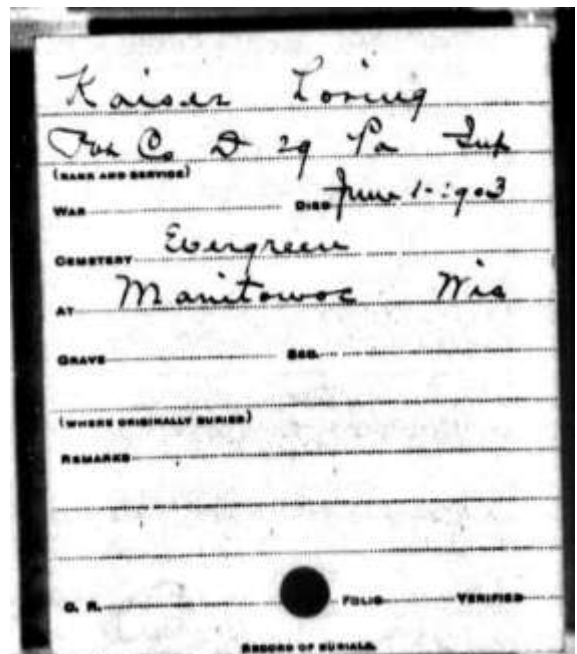

Der Nord Westen, 02 Apr. 1903: "A few days before his death Lorenz Kaiser, who served in the Civil War under the name August Herschoe, had been granted a pension of \$10 a month."

Der Nord Westen, May 19, 1904: "Several days ago Mrs. Kaiser, widow of the late Lorenz Kaiser, received her husband's back owed pension in the amount of about \$1,000."
