the correspondent in Kiel): "Death of
Abraham Kletzin, an old settler in Town
Schleswig, a few days ago. He served 4
yrs. in the Civil War. Burial will be
tomorrow."

Der Nord Westen, January 3, 1901: "Mrs.
Emilie Kletzien in St Nazianz, widow of
a Civil War veteran, has been awarded a
pension of \$8 a mo."
