Drafted: March 16, 1865 as a Private from Two Rivers, WI, 44 years old, Laborer, 5'2", blue eyes, brown hair

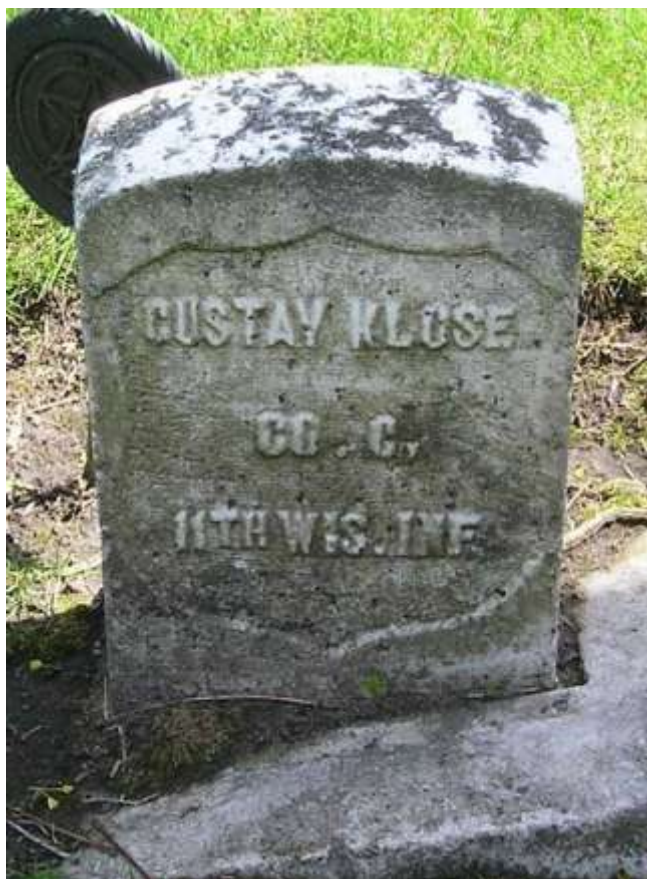
Discharged: September 4, 1865
