Der Nord Westen, 19 Feb. 1874: "Death of Franz Kunze on the 16th. About 48 years old. One of the first settlers in Sachsenburg. Born in Zichoppau in Sachsen; lived in Sachsenburg since the year 1847. Leaves widow and five sons."

Manitowoc Tribune February 20, 1874, Vol. 20 No. 52, Page 4 Column 5 Died. Franz Kunze -- In Saxonburgh, Town of Mishicott, Mr. Franz Kunze at the age of 48 years. The deceased was one of the earliest settlers in that town, arriving there in the year 1847, from Saxony. He leaves a sorrowing wife and five children, who, with their many friends, deplore his untimely death."
