Der Nord Westen, 27 Sep. 1900: "Stomach cancer caused the death Sun. of Wilhelm
Lemke following a long illness.
The deceased was born 76 yrs. ago
in Germany, came to America in
1853 and a few years later set-
tled in Manitowoc. During the
Civil War he served 9 months in
the Union Army. He is survived by
his widow and 4 children. The fu-
neral was held yesterday after-
noon with the local G.A.R. giving
him the final salute."

Der Nord Westen, November 7,
1901: "Mrs. Johanne Lemke, widow
of a Civil War veteran, has been
awarded a pension of \$8 a mo."
