Born: ca 1834 in Prussia

Enlisted: February 15, 1865 as a Private from Two Rivers, WI (on roll as Frederick Leonhard)

Der Nord Westen, 24 Sept. 1891: (From the correspondent in Two Rivers, 21 Sept.)

"Death last Thurs. of Fritz Lenhardt, an old settler here over 60 yrs. old. The deceased held the contract for conveying the mail between Kewaunee and Ahnapee, but had assigned the contract to his son and son-in-law."

Der Nord Westen, 20 Aug. 1908: (From the correspondent in Two Rivers, 17 Aug.)

"Elderly widow Mrs. F. Leonhardt, the mother of innkeeper Frank Leonhardt, was taken to her final rest Saturday with a large funeral. It was attended by relatives and friends from here, from Manitowoc, and from the entire area. The funeral was conducted from the Catholic Church."
