Der Nord Westen, 4 January 1883:

"Death of Heinrich (Henry) Mueller on Sat. from injuries received from a kick in the eyes by a horse. He was born 23 June 1821 in Zschopau in the Kingdom of Saxony, received a good education and studied agriculture. He came to America in 1846, married Wilhelmine Eberlein, then established himself in the Sachsenburg section of Town Mishicott. Shortly after the accident, his children were called to the bedside and on Sat. evening he died. The deceased leaves a widow and four already married sons as well as three daughters, one of whom is married to Anton Vogt. The youngest daughter is 14. Three of the sons live in Mishicott, and the fourth in Barton, Washington Co. The deceased served during the war in the 27th Wisc. Inf. Regt. and at his death was 61 years 6 mos 7 days old. The burial took place on Tues., 2 Jan. The fu-



neral procession was over a mile long. Mr. Florin Ott, a neighbor and close friend of the deceased, delivered the burial sermon."

History of Manitowoc County Wisconsin by Dr. L. Falge, 1911-1912, v.2, p.17-18 (part of bio of son Bruno Mueller): "Henry and Minnie (Heberlein) Mueller, natives of Germany who were married in Milwaukee, whence the former had come alone and the latter with her parents. In 1846 the family came to Manitowoc county, Henry Mueller securing a tract of wild land in Mishicot township, which he cleared from the wilderness and developed into an excellent farm, and he spent his life there being engaged in agricultural pursuits and participating actively in public matters, holding various township offices. He died December 30, 1882, his widow surviving him until 1905"
