Der Nord Westen, 02 Nov. 1893: Death in Two Rivers on Sat., after a long illness, of Louis Orth, a veteran of the Civil War. The cause of death was consumption which he, without doubt, contracted during the war especially since he was severely wounded at the Battle of Fredericksburg and lay on the battlefield without treatment for 48 hrs.
