Der Nord Westen, 08 Feb. 1900: "Death Thurs. of Town Rapids farmer Conrad Ostermann after a long illness with heart trouble. Mr. Ostermann had suffered a stroke several months ago from which he lay unconscious for several days. He never recovered from this incident. He leaves a widow and several grown children. He was born in Germany on 16 Aug. 1840 and came to America as a boy. He served during the Civil War with the 27th Wisconsin Infantry Regiment. His funeral was held Sun. at the local cemetery with a ceremony by the G.A.R."
