Der Nord Westen, 26 Mar. 1896: "Death of Mrs. Catharina Reichardt, wife of Michael Reichardt. She has been ill the past 5 mos. with cancer and traveled to Milwaukee last Fri. where she was admitted to the Presbyterian Hospital and an operation performed. News of her death was received early Tues. The body was brought here Tues. afternoon by her grieving husband. She leaves 6 grown children - 2 daughters (one married to a Mr. Lawrenz in Charlestown) and 4 sons. The deceased, who was 52, will be buried on Thurs. afternoon in the Kasson Cemetery."
