Born: September 15, 1835 in Munsterberg, Silesia, Prussia

In 1851, he came to Chicago, went thence to Milwaukee, thence to Fond du Lac, and thence to Calumet County. In 1852, he removed to Manitowoc, working at various kinds of work for several years, and in 1861 he enlisted in Company A, 5th Wis. V. I. Served three years. He participated in the battles of Gettysburg, of the Wilderness and Fair Oaks, Spottsylvania Courthouse and others. He then returned to Manitowoc, and established his present business in 1867. He married, in 1869, to Margaret Deidreich, of Bohemia, by whom he had six children, two sons and four daughters."

Der Nord Westen, 29 Aug. 1889: "Death of Mr. Edward Schindler yesterday evening, 28 Aug. after a long illness. He was born 15 Sept. 1835 in Münsterberg in the Prussian Province of Schlesia. He was a veteran of the Civil War and served 3 yrs. in Company 'A', 5th Wisconsin Regiment, serving with that regiment at Gettysburg, The Wilderness, Fair Oaks, Spottsylvania Court House, and other battles. He leaves a widow and 7 children. Burial will be Sat. morning at 9 a.m. at the Catholic Church."
