Schnese Family Tree, rootsweb.com: "Karl arrived in the USA on July 4 1862 and settled in Elgin, Ill. He joined the army on Feb 15 1864, in Elgin Ill and served 3 years. He was mustered into Co K of the 52nd regiment of the Illinois Infantry. On July 6 1865 he was discharged because of damage done to his hearing caused by an explosion. He married Elizabeth Silverson, daughter of Mikael Silberzahn) Silver-son & Elizabeth (Meier) Meyer, who was from Niles Center, Ill. on April 17 1866. They moved to Manitowoc, WI for 2 years and then moved to the farm in Denmark, WI."
