Born: March 16, 1813 in Baden, Germany

Enlisted: September 30, 1864 as a Private

Mustered Out: June 2, 1865

Wife: Theresia Bank

1885 Soldiers & Sailors of the Late War, Residing in Wisconsin, 1885: Joseph Sproll, I 18 WI, Post Office St Nazianz

1890 Veterans Schedule, Manitowoc County: Joseph Sproll, Pvt 18 I, post office St Nazianz; Not have—could not get discharge

1895 Veterans Census of Manitowoc County: Sproll, Joseph, Pvt 18th I Infantry—St Nazianz

Der Nord Westen, 28 September 1899: "Joseph Sproll of St. Nazianz has had his veteran's pension increased from \$8 to \$12 amonth.

Died: November 23, 1899

Buried: St Gregory Catholic Church, Eaton, WI

SPROLL Joseph..March 16, 1813-Nov. 23, 1899

-husband of Theresia nee Bank [married Feb. 16, 1857 at St. Gregory

-they are the first colony members to become married at St. Gregory]

-farmer

-born Baden

-arrived in New York on the ship Zurich from Havre, France on July 23, 1855

-on this same ship was his future wife, Theresia Bank

-veteran of the Civil War

-died from "dropsy and apoplexy")

-no stone
