Der Nord Westen, 16 May 1907: "Death Saturday of 76-year old Iver Tollefson after a long illness. The deceased, who was born in Norway, came to Manitowoc in 1854, moved on to Kansas in 1857, and in 1863 returned here where he has remained. He served the latter part of the Civil War in Company 'D' of the 45th Wisconsin Infantry Regiment. He is survived by his widow and 7 children. The funeral was held Tuesday afternoon."
