Moved in 1840's to Eaton area with Norton Kylor Johnson, whose wife, Marvelle (Maria), was a Tyler.

In Probate. In the matter of the Estate of Loretta J. Tyler, deceased. Notice is hereby given that at the general term of said County Court to be held in and for said County, at the office of the County Judge at the city of Manitowoc in said county, on the 1st Tuesday being the 3rd day of June 1884 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon of that day, the following matters will be heard and considered. The application of J.O. Tyler for a judgment of this court which shall determine who are all the heirs at law of Loretta J. Tyler late of the town of Eaton in said county, deceased intestate and what are their respective (?????) and interests in and to the title of said deceased to certain real estate whereof she died siezed and possessed and which is situate in said county and is known and described as



the East half of the West half of the South East Quarter of Section No. ten (10) of town No. eighteen (18) Range No. twenty one (21) being a tract of land containing forty acres more or less according to Government survey less one acre in the South East corner thereof used as a burying ground. Dated April 9th 1884. By the Court R.D. SMART, County Judge."

? The Lake Shore Times, Tuesday, September 23, 1884, P1: "NILES Mr. J. O. Tyler, started for Door County, last Thursday where he will spend a few weeks with his friends and relatives."
