Enlisted: February 14, 1865 as a Private from Two Rivers, WI, 20 year-old Farmer, 5'7", blue eyes, sandy hair.
Mustered Out: July 17, 1865 at Nashville, TN

1870 Federal Census: WI, Manitowoc County, Two Rivers Twp/John Willert family:
Heinrick Willert, 28, Farm laborer, b Mecklenburg

Married: Heinrich Willert on 24 Feb 1873 to Friedericke Rammin

Manitowoc County Chronicle, October 1, 1878: "Struck by Lightning. The brilliant light seen west of this place last Wednesday morning was caused by the burning of a large barn belonging to a farmer named Henry WILLERT. The barn was struck by lightning and entirely consumed, together with all its contents of grain, hay, etc. A valuable span of horses, fortunately, were rescued. Two large hogs, which were in the barn, were burned. The barn was a large one, 40x60, but was insured for \$600. The barn contained upwards of twenty-five tons of hay, on which there was an insurance of \$100. This the total amount of insurance, while the loss is estimated at \$900. Seven years ago, during the memorable forest fires of 1871, Mr. WILLERT's house and barns, upon the same farm, were entirely consumed by fire."

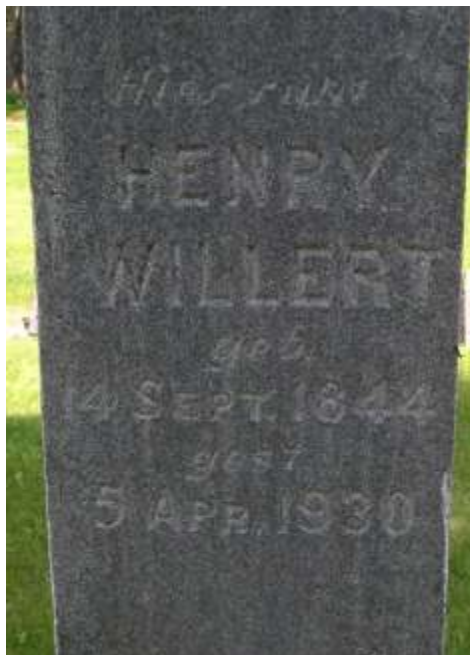
