Der Nord Westen, 01 Feb. 1906: A heart attack took the life of Mrs. Henriette Winter here on Monday. Mrs. Winter had gone to the courtyard of her residence, 823 South 18th Street, to fetch a bucket of water when she suffered an attack, sank down and died. No one missed her until a little girl, who was passing by, saw the body on the ground and reported her discovery. Nearby doctors who were summoned could only confirm her death. Mrs. Winter who was 74, came to Manitowoc County from Germany 35 years ago. The family settled in Town Gibson and the deceased remained a resident there until about two years ago when she moved to the residence here of her son, Gottlieb Winter. She is survived by 8 sons and one daughter. Her funeral will be held tomorrow afternoon.
